



What to Bring on the First Day of School

Welcome to school! We're so glad to have you. Below is a checklist of items to bring with you on the first day of school.

- Application and registration fee (if not already sent it in)
- Carpool student release form, emergency release form, enrollment agreement
- Signed handbook
- Immunization forms (hearing, vision, and dental screenings for kindergarteners)
 - COPYS ONLY, please
- Snack and lunch
 - Snack should be placed in a paper bag and contain **one** food and one drink.
 - Lunch should be in a separate, insulated bag.
 - Both snack and lunch should come with a drink and **two** napkins.
 - We do have a microwave to heat up lunch items. Leftovers are always delicious and very popular.
 - Please do not send children with GoGurts (squeezable yogurt), deserts, candy, whole grapes (please cut in halves or quarters), whole hotdogs (please cut lengthwise), or popcorn.
- Change of clothes including underwear and socks (please label all items).
Two pairs of clothing is recommended for potty training children.
 - Diapers and wipes are requested for children who are not yet potty trained.
- Toys, dolls, blankets should be left at home for all Lower and Upper Primary students. Toddlers should limit items to one "comfort doll/blanket", but please note that these can occasionally be left at school and make for a very difficult bedtime.
 - Sunglasses, costumes, balloons, and money should be left at home for all students.
- Please come through carpool during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up. When you come inside to drop off or pick up your child, it upsets the other students and reminds them that their own mommy is not there.

***Please label EVERYTHING!!!! This includes coats, shoes, rain boots, shirts, pants, underwear, sippy cups, plates, platters, Tupperware, etc.

***Also, we do spend a considerable amount of time outdoors, so please apply sunscreen and bug spray to your child each morning.
